

Warmaster's Challenge 2010 Q & A

Q. May Albion units and Rhinox Cavalry be used?

A. Yes, they may all be used.

Q. Will the tournament use the "slide rule" recommended in FAQ#1 in order to further maximize the number of models in contact?

A. Sliding to maximize combatants will be the default rule for aligning combats, unless both teams agree to use clipping.

Q. Regarding the Casket of Souls, which takes precedence, the specific Tomb King FAQ that states that units can use magic resistance against it, or the (newer) General Warhammer FAQ that requires the unit to be the target?

A. The specific Tomb King FAQ takes precedence. Enemy units that could be affected by the casket may use their magic resistance.

NOTE: IF GW releases an FAQ on Beastmen and/or Skaven between now and the Tournament, their rulings take precedent over ours.

Skaven FAQ

Q. Is the Storm Banner One use only, or can it be activated multiple times?

A. The Storm Banner may be activated multiple times.

Q. Are Warpstone Tokens multiple use or one use only?

A. The Warpstone Tokens are "consumed" and are therefore one use only.

Q. How does the Doomwheel move? Must the player declare a direction before rolling? How often can it wheel?

A. The Doomwheel has no stipulation that the direction must be declared before rolling, so it can move freely, and may wheel as a chariot. This means that in a turn in which it makes contact with an enemy, it may only have wheeled once to make contact.

Q. Does the Doomwheel need to declare charges?

- A. Yes. Because the Doomwheel may dictate the direction in which it is headed, it must declare a charge (like a chariot). This means that players may not use its controlled movement to make contact with an enemy without a charge declaration.
- Q. May a Screaming Bell or Plaque Furnace be repositioned in a unit during combat (so the character may fight)?
- A. No, the bell must remain in the middle of the unit. During combat there is no way for those pushing the machine to move it into position.

Beastmen FAQ

- Q. Does each ambushing unit require its own mirror unit to start on the table, or can a single unit on the table count as the mirror unit for multiple ambushing units?
- A. Each ambushing unit requires its own mirror unit on the table.
- Q. If the number of wound inflicted on the Jabberslyth exceeds its remaining wounds, how many Spurting Bile-Blood attacks does it inflict?
- A. The number of Spurting Bile-Blood attacks inflicted are equal to the number of remaining wounds.
